Chatzifotiou Sevaste is a Professor of Social Work, Gender and Domestic Violence, at the Department of Social Work, Democritus University of Thrace.

She is teaching undergraduate courses on "Gender and Equality", "Qualitative Research Methods", "Social Work and Domestic Violence", and "Ethics in Social Work Practice", and also in Masters courses on "Methodology in Social and Educational Research ", "Teaching in a diverse universe of students", and coordinates MA workshops on "Research Methods". She has been supervising doctoral dissertations on domestic violence and social work, the use of internet from minors living in child protection services, social work in education, social work with refugees, two of which have been completed with merit. Further, she is the Director of of the MA in "Social Policy and Social Work" in the department of Social Work, at D.U.Th., that is going to be completed in 2023. She is also a member of the Interdepartmental Committee of the MA in "Didactics of Science and New Technologies" run by International Hellenic University and D.U.Th.

She is the Head of the Gender Equality Committee of D.U.Th. and represents the university at the Gender Equality Committee of the Municipality of Eastern Macedonia and Thrace.

Her research interests focus on gender discriminations, domestic violence, child protection, social work in education, social work with vulnerable populations, qualitative research methodologies, ethics and values in social work.

She studied Social Work at TEI of Patras where she awarded a BA in Social Work (1992), and further awarded an MA in Social and Community Work Studies (Bradford University, UK, 1993), and an MA in Social Research Methods (University of Manchester, UK, 1997).
