### Charalampos Pouloupoulos

Charalampos Pouloupoulos is Professor of Social Work at the Department of Social Work, Democritus University of Thrace. He teaches at the undergraduate courses the classes “Social Work in the Addictions”, “Social Work with Groups”, “Educational Supervision and Personal Development”, “The consequences of socio-economic crises – social interventions” and “Justice, Delinquency and Social Work with Minors” and at the post-graduate course on “Social Work in Education and Inclusion of Otherness”, the classes “Addictions and Internet” and “Group Dynamics: Experiences and Lived Spaces”.

Charalampos Pouloupoulos is the Chairman of the Board of IC&RC (International Certification & Reciprocity Consortium Alcohol and Other Drugs) for Greece, Cyprus, Bulgaria and Malta and Member of the Ethics Committee of the European Federation of Therapeutic Communities.

He is also a member of the scientific committee of the peer review journals, “Social Work: Review of Social Sciences”, “Review of Counseling and Guidance” and ‘Exartiseis’.

For his overall contribution in the field of drug treatment and prevention, in September 2019, he received for the European Federation of Therapeutic Communities, the distinguished Eric Broekaert Award.

His research interests focus on the treatment and prevention of addiction, on group dynamics and counseling and supervising organizations with special emphasis on the process of change and crisis management and intervention.

He studied Social Work in Greece and received his PhD from Bradford University, UK. In UK he also carried with post-doctoral research at the Institute of Psychiatry, King’s College, London.

He started his career in the field of drug addiction treatment in year 1983 and he contributed to the development of the Greek Therapeutic Communities. Between 1995-2013 he was the Director of the Therapy Centre for Dependent Individuals (KETHEA).
