

## SERBOS SOTIRIS

Dr. Sotiris Serbos is an Associate Professor of International Politics in the Department of Social Work at Democritus University of Thrace, in Greece. At the undergraduate level he teaches: 1) The Structure of International Society: An Introduction to the Study of International Relations, 2) EU: History, Institutions, and Policies, 3) International Negotiations and Crisis Management, 4) The International Politics of Migration and Refugee Flows in South-Eastern Europe. At the graduate level (Master's program in Contemporary European Studies, Law Faculty) he teaches the course "EU in the World".

He is a member of the peer review committee in the Journal of International Relations and in international professional associations (International Studies Association, University Association for Contemporary European Studies, European Union Study Association, Academic Council on the United Nations System). He is a senior research fellow at the Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy (ELIAMEP) and member of the scientific committee in International Student Model United Nations and other international organizations.

In 2012, he was selected as SUSI Scholar of the US Institute on American Politics and Political Thought. In the field of transatlantic relations and for the academic year 2014-2015, he was awarded a Fulbright Fellowship at The Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University and the University of Pittsburgh's EU Center of Excellence. Serbos' research interests focus on foreign policy analysis (Turkey, US, EU), European integration and transatlantic relations.

A full-scholarship student of Anatolia College. He studied International Relations at the University of Macedonia (BA), the London School of Economics & Political Science (MSc) and the National & Kapodistrian University of Athens (PhD). Awards for academic excellence include scholarships from the State Scholarships Foundation (IKY). He has six years of service as scientific director for policy planning, special adviser in the Hellenic Ministries of Foreign Affairs, Defense, Economy & Finance and Macedonia - Thrace. Further policy experience in international negotiations and capacity development in foreign policy strategic planning. Before joining Democritus University, he taught Public Administration and Policy at the Hellenic Open University and International Relations at the American College of Thessaloniki. From 2010, he has also been involved in international consulting services (Gerson Lehrman Group).

He has participated in eight important national and international research projects (ESRC, NATO, Europe Aid, NSRF, OPCE). He has published 35 papers in books, edited volumes, scientific journals and his recent publications include: 1. "Revisiting Europe's Geopolitical Landscape after the Ukraine Crisis: America's Balance of Power Strategy", 2. "Redefining transatlantic security relations: Europe's struggle to be strategic", 3. "From Afghanistan to Australia: America's Balance of Power Strategy".
